**This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead from Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019.** The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1.05m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, **Eventers Challenge** from 60cm through to 1m.

**Qualification: 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> in dressage, show jumping & showing and 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> in eventers challenges.**

## EQUIFEST

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the **29<sup>th</sup> Aug – 1<sup>st</sup> Sep 2019**. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

### **Arena 1 9:30am start (Grass Arena)**

**CLASS 1: Best Turned Out.** Horses and ponies of all heights and ages. CAN BE ON LEAD REIN OR NOT Any suitable bit.

**CLASS 2: Lead Rein.** This is open for ponies not exceeding 128cm (12hh). Open to mares and geldings 4 years and over. Children must be 3 years or older but not have reached their 9th birthday on 1st Jan 2019. Class maybe split Show Pony/M&M if sufficient entries. *Equifest Qualifier* - The Miller Family / Equifest Show Ponies Lead Rein & Cavernoma Alliance UK / Equifest Mountain and Moorland Lead Rein.

**CLASS 3: First Ridden.** This class may be split at the final between This is open for ponies not exceeding 128cm (12.2hh). Open to mares and geldings 4 years and over. Children must not have reached their 11th birthday on 1st Jan 2019.

**CLASS 4: Pony Club/Riding Club Pony.** For ponies not exceeding 153cm that make good all rounders for Riding Club activities. Open to mares or geldings 4 years and over. Riders exceeding 25 years on 1st Jan 2019. For small adults who ride ponies. Open to mares and geldings, 4 years and over. Ponies may be asked to jump a small fence at the finals. Any suitable bit.

**CLASS 5: Most Photogenic Horse/Pony.** Sponsored and judged by Fae Loudon Photography

**CLASS 6: Prettiest Mare**

**CLASS 7: Handomest Gelding**

*Class 8. Best Junior Rider*

**CLASS 9: Best Mane & Tail.**

**CLASS 10: Thelwell look-a-like**

**CLASS 11: Young Handler.** Section a) for children who are younger than 10 years on 1st Jan 2019 Section b) for under 14 years by 1st Jan 2019 but are over 10 years.

**CLASS 12: Pony or Horse Judge would most like to take home.**

**CLASS 13: Handy Pony** Competitors will negotiate 8 obstacles which will be judged out of 10 and against the clock.

**CLASS 13: Fancy Dress.**

**ARENA 2 09:30am start**

**CLASS 14: In hand Youngstock.** Any Breed. Not to exceed 148cms at maturity. 4 years old and under

**CLASS 15: In-hand Youngstock.** Any Breed. To exceed 148cms at maturity. 4 years old and under.

**CLASS 16a: Coloured Horse/Pony.** In-hand *BSPA/Equifest In hand Piebald/Skewbald Qualifier - Open in hand Piebald/skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules and conditions.*

**CLASS 16b: Coloured Horse/Pony Ridden:** *BSPA/Equifest Ridden Piebald/Skewbald Qualifier - Open ridden piebald/skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules and conditions.*

**CLASS 17: Riding Club Horse.** For horses exceeding 153cm (15hh) that make good all rounders for Riding Club activities. Open to mares and geldings 4 years and over. ANY SUITABLE BIT.

CLASS 18a: **Ridden Veteran.** Horses/Ponies must be over 15 years of age. *VHS Qualifier*

CLASS 18b: **In-hand Veteran.** Open to any horse 15 years or over. *VHS Qualifier*

CLASS 19a: **Large Ridden Breed Mountain & Moorland.** Open to registered and unregistered. Class will be split if sufficient entries. *Equifest Mountain & Moorland Qualifier Open Ridden-* registered ponies only will qualify for Equifest.

CLASS 19b: **Small Ridden Breed Mountain & Moorland.** Open to registered and unregistered. Class will be split if sufficient entries. *Equifest Mountain & Moorland Qualifier Open Ridden-* registered ponies only will qualify for Equifest.

CLASS 20a: **In-hand Mountain & Moorland – Large Breeds.** Open to registered and unregistered. *Spillers/Equifest Mountain & Moorland Qualifier In Hand – Open to in hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.*

CLASS 20b: **In-hand Mountain & Moorland.** Open to registered and unregistered. *Spillers/Equifest Mountain & Moorland Qualifier In Hand – Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age.*

CLASS 21a: **Local Ridden Hunter.** Competitors must live within a 25mile radius of Wing JDC. Horse's will not be ridden by the judge, ridden show will be required.

CLASS 21b: **Ridden Hunter:** Horses will not be ridden by the judge, ridden show will be required. *Black Country Saddle/Equifest Ridden Hunter Qualifier – Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.*

**Classes may be divided as follows:**

- *Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying 12.7stone*
- *Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone*
- *Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.*

CLASS 22a: **Ridden Cob** - For horses over 148cm. Cobs may be shown hogged, plaited or unplaited. Open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. *Nupafeed/Equifest Ridden Cob Qualifier – Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.*

**Classes may be divided as follows:**

- *Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms*
- *Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.*

CLASS 22b **Maxi Cob.**

*Future Images Ltd/Equifest Maxi Cob Qualifier. Open Maxi Cobs,, mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 155cm – to be judged as cobs.*

**CLASS 23: Re-Trained Race Horse.** This is open to Thoroughbreds who have retired from racing and are now retrained. Horses must have raced and be able to show a race record. Horses will be expected to do a freestyle show at the qualifiers. Horses must be 15hh (153cm) and over. Open to geldings and mares only, 4 years and over. Blemishes are not considered. Horses must be registered with Weatherby's General Stud book or an overseas equivalent. Riders must have reached 17years of age by 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019. The judge will not ride.

### **Arena 3: 09:00am start**

**CLEAR ROUND JUMPING ROUND GRASS ARENA (this is dependant in the ground it may be in the ménage. Please check wit secretary nearer the time) £5 per round or 3 rounds for £12**

*Clear round rosettes to be given to all clear rounds.*

9-10am – x poles

10-11am – 50-60cm

11-12noon – 60-70cm

### **Class 24 to start approximately 1:30pm**

**CLASS 24: Cradle Stakes:** Ponies not to exceed 133cm. Riders not to have reached their 10<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> Jan 2019. Jumps will be x poles not to exceed 35cm.

**CLASS 25: Nursery Stakes:** Ponies not to exceed 133cm Riders not to have reached their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1st Jan 2019 Jumps 50cm max. over a short course.

**CLASS 26: Working Hunter Pony:** Ponies not exceeding 14.2hh. Jumps approx. 75cm KBIS / *Equifest Qualifier – Working hunter pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride. Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019. Classes may be divided as follows:*

- *Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019*
- *Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.*
- *Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cm but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.*
- *Open Intermediate Working Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.*

**CLASS 27: Novice Working Hunter: Horses exceeding 14.2hh. Jumps approx. 75-85cm** – Stallion, mare and gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms  
*Riders of stallions to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.*

**CLASS 28: Working Hunter Open:** Horses exceeding 14.2hh. Jumps approx. 90cm. *Equifest Open Working Hunter Qualifier* – Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, Riders of stallions to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019. *Maximum height of fences 1.14m (3'9") at the discretion of the judges.*

## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. The Show Organizer referred to in these Rules & Regulations shall hereinafter mean Wing Jumping & Dressage Centre. The Wing JDC Traditional Family Showing Show will hereinafter be referred to as the Show.
2. Open to All horses and ponies
3. The Show, Show Organiser, Volunteer & Officials do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
4. The Show Organiser retains its absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
5. Competitions: The Show Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions, as they think fit.
6. Collecting Ring: All warming up must be done in the designated Collecting Rings provided. Persons found abusing horses on the showground may be asked to leave.
7. Represented Cheques or Credit Cards: Any payment that has to be represented to the bank for whatever reason will be subject to a £15.00 administration fee for each occasion.
8. Vehicles: The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.
9. Dogs: Dogs are permitted but MUST be kept under control and on a lead at all times. Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the Showground.
10. Prize Giving: the Show organizer reserves the right to withhold prizes if competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving
11. Objections: Objection should be made in writing in accordance. Two Show Stewards will be appointed to the Show.
12. Official Photographs: Any photographs taken at the Show by the Official Photographer may be used by the Show Organiser for promotional purposes.
13. First Aid: We have first aiders on site and do not charge extra for first aid cover.

14. Vaccination Certificate: All horses at the show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of certificate and any horse found without a valid certificate will be asked to leave the show ground.
15. Stallions: No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury.
16. Close of entries: Entries will close at the start of each class, to guarantee you entry before the Show.
17. All VHS qualifers will abide by the following: No galloping or spurs permitted. Basic walk, trot and canter. Clear transition must be shown. Mark system will be general: condition and movement in relation to age and turnout. Stallions handler or rider must be of 16years. Turnout in accordance with breed. Red qualification for members. Green qualification for Non-Members.

Please read carefully the General Rules & Regulations. Any person coming to the show or involved in any aspect of the meeting is deemed bound by the Rules & Regulations.
